Wednesday, December 20, 2017

8:20-9:55 3rd Block Exam

10:00-11:30 4th Block Exam

Early Dismissal at 11:30 for ALL students.

FINAL EXAMS:

All courses will have a final assessment, to include those classes that took an EOC test. Students are expected to attend school on final exam days.

- Final exams will not be given early.
- Students who miss a final exam or an EOC will receive a zero (0) on the exam which will be calculated into their final grade. See make-up exam opportunity below.
- Students must remain in class until the end of the period. Under no circumstances will students be allowed to leave an exam early.
- Students who are exempting a final exam do not have to be at school during the time the exam is being administered; however, transportation is left to the parents.

MAKE-UP EXAM OPPORTUNITY:

Make-up exams for **excused absences only**, will take place on Wednesday, January 3rd at 8:30 am in the Media Center. Students must clear their absence through the principal, Mr. Kelly.

EARLY DISMISSAL:

Bus service will be provided at the 11:30 am dismissal time on Tuesday, December 19th and Wednesday, December 20th. ALL students must leave campus immediately at 11:30, either by riding the bus or having arrangements for transportation. Students should not return to school during the rest of that school day. Please note that Cobb County policy states that students dismissed early may NOT go on other school campuses, including elementary and middle schools. Doing so may result in disciplinary action.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- School is back in session for all students on Thursday, January 4th, 2018.
- Report cards will be available electronically through Studentvue/Parentvue Friday, January 5th, 2018.
- Students will return fall semester textbooks before leaving for winter break. Students will not be issued their Spring Semester books if there are any books that have not been turned in or if there are any outstanding fines. Students and their parents are financially obligated for any lost or damaged books.
